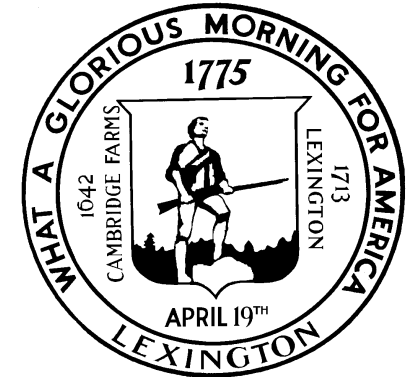

- Adult Supportive Day Care Program: A supervised social day program designed to provide structure and safety for older adults and respite for family caregivers.
- Nutrition/Meals on Wheels: Lunch is offered daily at the Senior Center for a donation. Meals on Wheels are home delivered daily by volunteers.
- Senior Health Outreach Programs: Nursing consultation, wellness home visits, assessments, and weekly community blood pressure screenings.

The Lexington Human Services Department maintains strong working relationships with other municipal departments, community groups, and local service providers. The Human Services Department serves as a central point of access for social services for all Lexington residents.
