

Marrett-Waltham Intersection Construction
Spring-Summer 2011
Frequently Asked Questions

1. What will the project look like?

The intersection work will include traffic signal reconstruction, pavement widening and resurfacing, sidewalk reconstruction, signage, and lighting. The project will improve pedestrian and vehicular safety and increase traffic volume capacity. A copy of the final design for can be viewed on the Town's website at:

2. How long will the project take?

Verizon has already begun moving utilities in the area. Construction will begin in early April, and it is expected to be completed by November 26, 2011.

3. Will I lose electricity, water, or sewer during the construction?

There are no planned disruptions of any utility services, including water, electricity, gas, or phone.

4. Will I lose street access during the construction?

The intersection will remain open throughout construction, with police details provided by the Lexington Police Department when necessary. At least one driveway access to each property will be maintained at all times.

5. How large will the construction crew be? What kind of equipment will be used?

There will be approximately 4-5 construction workers and 3 pieces of equipment on site. More or larger equipment may be brought in for specific portions of the project.

6. Where will the construction parking and staging areas be?

Specific staging areas have not yet been determined. MassDOT will contact businesses a day in advance if a staging area will cause any interruptions on the property.

7. Who do I contact for additional information about this project?

Contact information is available here for the Town's Engineering Department, Economic Development Office, and MassDOT representatives. Additional contact information will be available once a field office is set up closer to the beginning of construction.
