

TOWN OF LEXINGTON VOTER REGISTRATION

SEPTEMBER 8, 2016 STATE PRIMARY

The Board of Registrars remind all resident citizens who will be 18 years of age on or before September 8, 2016, not currently registered to vote in Lexington, that 8:00 p.m. **Friday, August 19, 2016** is the deadline to register to vote for the September 8, 2016 State Primary. The voter registration deadline is **20 days prior** to all local, state and national elections.

Voter Registration can be completed in one of three ways:

- Online at <https://www.sec.state.ma.us/OVR/> To submit an online application, you must have a valid driver's license, learner's permit, or non-driver ID issued by the Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV). You must also have a signature on file with the RMV.
- Mail-in voter registration affidavit forms are available at the Town Clerk's Office and online at <http://www.sec.state.ma.us/ele/eleifv/howreg.htm>. Forms are also available from other City or Town Clerk offices. Registrations filed out-of-town will be forwarded to Lexington.
- In Person at the Office of the Town Clerk.

Voter registration is on-going throughout the year, special walk-in voter registrations will be conducted at the Lexington Town Clerk's Office on **August 19, 2016 from 8:30 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.**

All newly registered voters submitting mail-in voter registrations must submit a photocopy of personal identification. Sufficient identification includes a copy of a current and valid photo identification, current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document showing your name and address. Voter registration forms also require the voter to provide his/her driver license number or last four digits of his/her social security number.

Voter Registration forms postmarked on or before the respective deadline, and Registry of Motor Vehicle registrations completed on or before the respective deadline, will be accepted for voting in the upcoming election.

Residents already registered to vote in Lexington need not register again for any election.

Registered voters who have recently moved within Lexington, who wish to confirm political party in which registered, or who have not responded to the annual town census may confirm status at the State web site <https://www.sec.state.ma.us/VoterRegistrationSearch/MyVoterRegStatus.aspx> or should contact the Town Clerk's office at 781-862-0500 ext. 84558 or townclerk@lexingtonma.gov to verify registration status.
