- Review of DPW answer to Ad Hoc Report – Commission asked for exacting precise specifications if wire-cut brick is chosen and this is first answer that some specifications will be differently followed
- Update and follow-up on Bridge School front entrance – inaccessible gathering area

- Preparing for December meeting about ADA transition plan with Shawn Newell, Assistant Director of Public Facilities – last October he told us that the Master List still had 82 items for Shawn’s group and 106 items needing to be completed out of the original 374 items on it in 2012 – does Commission want to discuss how we can avoid retro-fitting (like special PTA projects, fundraisers, etc.)
