


Chiesa Farm

23 acres, 1 mile of trails. Chiesa Farm is one of Lexington's most scenic properties, with an open, rolling field that is visible along Adams Street. A stone bench on the knoll in the field provides an opportunity to enjoy the view. The front field was previously used as a horse pasture but is now open to the public.

Access is from Sedge Road near Diamond Middle School and from Adams Street through a break in the fence. A trail enters from behind the Pilgrim Congregational Church (on their property) on Coolidge Avenue. Please be respectful of the church's property when using this trail.
