

LEXINGTON HOUSING ASSISTANCE BOARD (LEXHAB)

Members: no fewer than 5
Appointed by: Board of Selectmen
Length of Term: 3 years, staggered
Appointments made: May 31
Meeting Times: Monthly – date varies each month

Description: The Board was established for the purpose of investigating and implementing alternatives for the provision of affordable housing in Lexington and for providing such housing for persons of low, moderate and middle income, and others whose needs may be identified from time to time. The powers and duties of this Board are intended to supplement and not limit the powers and duties of the Lexington Housing Authority.

Criteria for Membership: Background in engineering, finance, business, real estate, town government, law and development for persons of housing of low and moderate income.
