


Liberty Heights

5.5 acres, 0.25 miles of trails. Although it is small, Liberty Heights provides a refreshing touch of green in one of Lexington's more densely developed residential neighborhoods. The area is forested with mature red and white oak, ash, hickory, and cherry trees, and a small grassy forested area sits on the east side.

Access is from Bowker Street, the end of Hillside Avenue, and the end of Ann Street.
