


Willard's Woods

100 acres, 3 miles of trails. Willard's Woods offers visitors the opportunity to wander through the open meadows, pine groves, and wetlands of an old farm. Two streams cross the area, and the meadows contain a variety of wild flowers, including an occasional asparagus plant. Fox, raccoon, opossum, deer, coyote, and many bird species frequent Willard's Woods. A short bicycle path runs from Hathaway Road and Brent Road to North Street.

A large parking area is available on North Street. Access is from North Street, Redcoat Lane, Hathaway Road, Longfellow Road, Brent Road, and the Diamond Middle School parking lot.
