



On June 1, 2022, the Lexington Public Schools began the Massachusetts School Building Authority's (MSBA's) Eligibility Period for a new or renovated Lexington High School. As part of the MSBA Eligibility period, this committee has been formed. The School Building Committee's purpose is generally to monitor the application process and to advise during the construction of an approved project. Districts that successfully complete the preliminary requirements to the satisfaction of the MSBA within the 270-day Eligibility Period are eligible to receive an invitation from the MSBA Board of Directors to the Feasibility Study phase.
