

This Plan of the Town of Lexington contains 10300 Acres
 Roads Brooks &c. included. This survey was taken in
 October & November 1794. and projected according to the
 Meridia at that date and laid down by the scale of
 200 rods to one inch. The red lines through the Plan are
 the Public Roads the black lines are small brooks.

 Green: Waltham Red. the distance from the Center to
