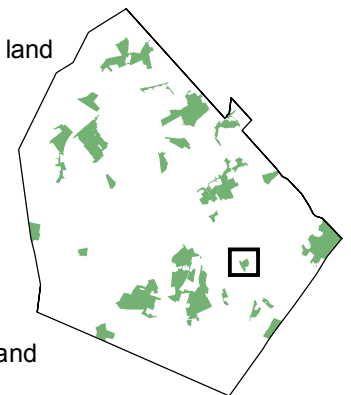
## Joyce Miller's Meadow

10 acres, 0.6 miles of trails (Joyce Miller's Meadow alone); 185 acres, 5 miles of trails (with Arlington's Great Meadow). Joyce Miller's Meadow is a small property that adjoins larger Arlington's Great Meadow, which belongs to the Town of Arlington but sits within Lexington's borders. A network of trails crosses both properties, winding through forests, meadows, and wetlands. Access is from Arlington's Great Meadow and from the Minuteman Bikeway 1/10th of a mile southeast of Maple Street.
