## Brown Homestead

6 acres, 0.1 miles of trail. Brown Homestead is a small, mostly wet conservation area named after Farmer Brown who, as a Minuteman, stood with Captain Parker on Lexington Green during the historic events at the start of the revolution in 1775. One short trail crosses the property from the Minuteman Bikeway to Munroe Brook, but it does not continue through to an exit.

Access is from the Minuteman Bikeway approximately 1/3 mile east of Lexington's Town Offices building and opposite the back side of Munroe Cemetery.
