

## LEXINGTON BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Members: 13, of whom four are representatives of town boards and nine are interested citizens  
Appointed by: Board of Selectmen  
Length of Term: Three years  
Appointments made: September 30, staggered  
Meeting times: 2nd Thursday of every month at 7:30 p.m. Joint meetings with Friends of the Bikeway

Description: The Committee shall advise the Selectmen on all matters relating to bicycle routes and general bicycle policy to serve the best interests of the Town of Lexington and its citizens and those of neighboring communities affected by these facilities.

Criteria for Membership: The citizens should be committed to the functioning of the Committee. Citizen members will serve for three-year terms on a staggered basis, with three to be appointed or reappointed each year at the end of September.

A position of honorary membership shall be given for life to individuals by unanimous committee vote for their extraordinary service to committee goals and to the community at large.
